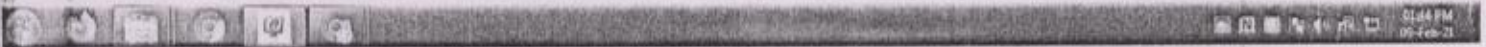

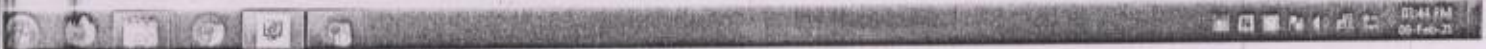

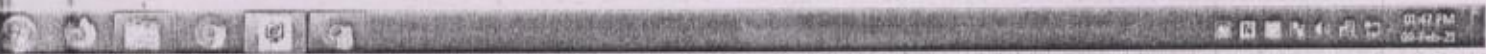

- Students mapping to own department NDE subject is prevented.

4) Time Table(Master, Day wise, Date Wise, Teacher Time Table)

- Additional Student Group will be there for NDE subject, which will be the same group mapped to the academic year and department.
- Attendance Entry: - All students mapped to the NDE subject group from other departments will be displayed for attendance marking. Students list will be sorted by department wise. Attendance entry will be using admission number instead of roll number. Attendance entry will be done by the department which the subject belongs to.
- Swap, Timetable Change, Extra Class and Handover will not work for NDE subjects

- NDE Hour on time table should be same for all departments.
- Holiday and Suspension will be enabled for NDE hours.
