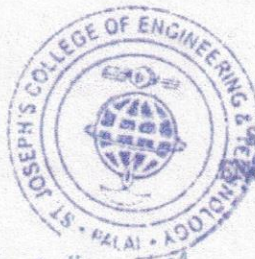

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

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 1.4 Second Party shall be generally responsible for the administrative and academic implementation of the entire training program.
- 1.5 Second Party shall nominate one of their faculty members who has dedication and Inclination to ASAP as the ASAP Nodal officer and he shall be responsible for the following:
- a) Organizing and monitoring the smooth conduct of the training.
 - b) Ensuring regular student attendance, quality programme delivery, and punctuality of the SDE/trainer. Nodal officer shall responsible for intimating the class schedule, recording of the attendance and effectively co-ordinating the training in the Institution. He/she shall also be responsible for maintaining records and accounts of ASAP
- 1.6 Second Party shall be responsible for providing quality infrastructure throughout the course period, failing which ASAP holds the right to discontinue the course. The continuance of the existing batches or sanction of new batches in the

institution will be solely based on the quality of the infrastructure facilities provided and the administrative support and cooperation extended by the institution.

- 1.7 Second Party shall collect the prescribed fee from the students as per the schedule being communicated from ASAP on a time bound basis and shall remit to the ASAP account on the next working day itself
- 1.8 Student selection for the ASAP Programme will start with an orientation session/s conducted by the Programme Manager of ASAP. The Second Party shall arrange for / permit the Programme Manager to conduct awareness programmes to the students and parents by the Programme Manager. The interested students shall be supplied with application forms for the ASAP course which is to be collected and scrutinised by the committee constituted for the purpose.
- 1.9 A committee consists of the Manager/ PTA President, Principal, Nodal officer, Head of the Department, Programme Manager and SDE shall be constituted for the administration, coordination and monitoring of ASAP activities.
- 1.10 Second Party agrees that ASAP Kerala holds the right to monitor the entire process of training through multipronged approach to ensure the quality of the training and to visit and verify any records, documents and information related to the implementation of the programme in the institution and that ASAP reserves all the rights to discontinue the training programme at any time without assigning any reason.
- 1.11 Nodal Officer: The Second Party shall nominate and authorize one of the faculty members of Second Party as Nodal officer, as a single point of contact, on behalf of Additional Skill Acquisition Programme Kerala to coordinate the launch and successful implementation of the Programmes.
- 1.12 Faculty coordinator: Second Party shall nominate and approved by Additional Skill Acquisition Programme to train /facilitate theory or practical at the institution, approved by Additional Skill Acquisition Programme Kerala in face to face teaching,

SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Skill Development Programs:** First Party to train the students of Second Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

- 2.5 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein
- 2.6 There is no financial commitment on the part of the NAME OF INSTITUTION, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY



TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE


- 4.1 The Parties agree that the duration of this MoU shall be for 3 (Three) years from the date of signing, which shall also be the effective date of the MoU.
- 4.2 This MoU may be extended by mutual written agreement of the Parties.
- 4.3 The Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **Name of Institution**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.4 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior
