Women's Day Celebration -EVAREYNA'23

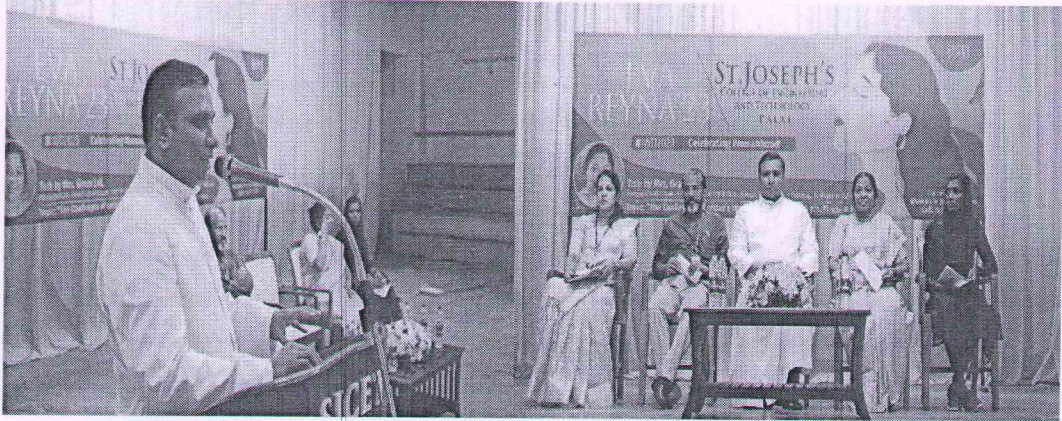
