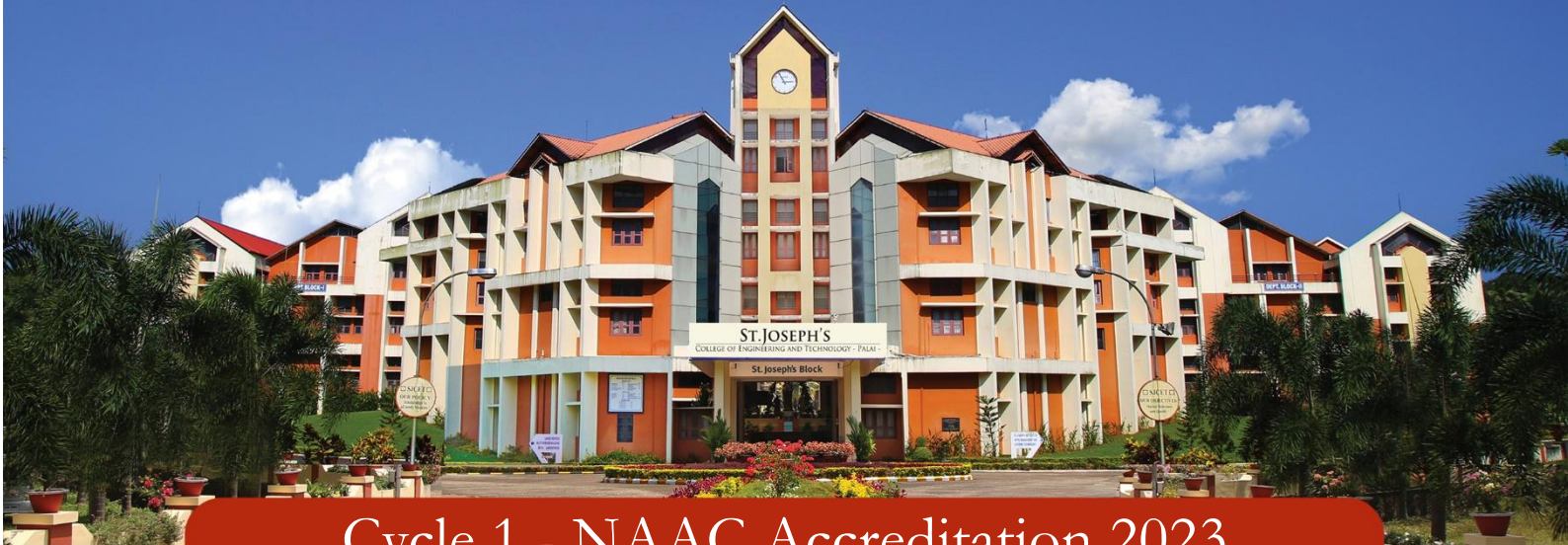

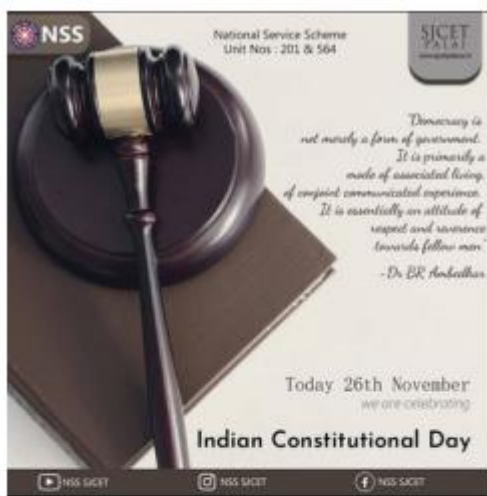

December 22nd

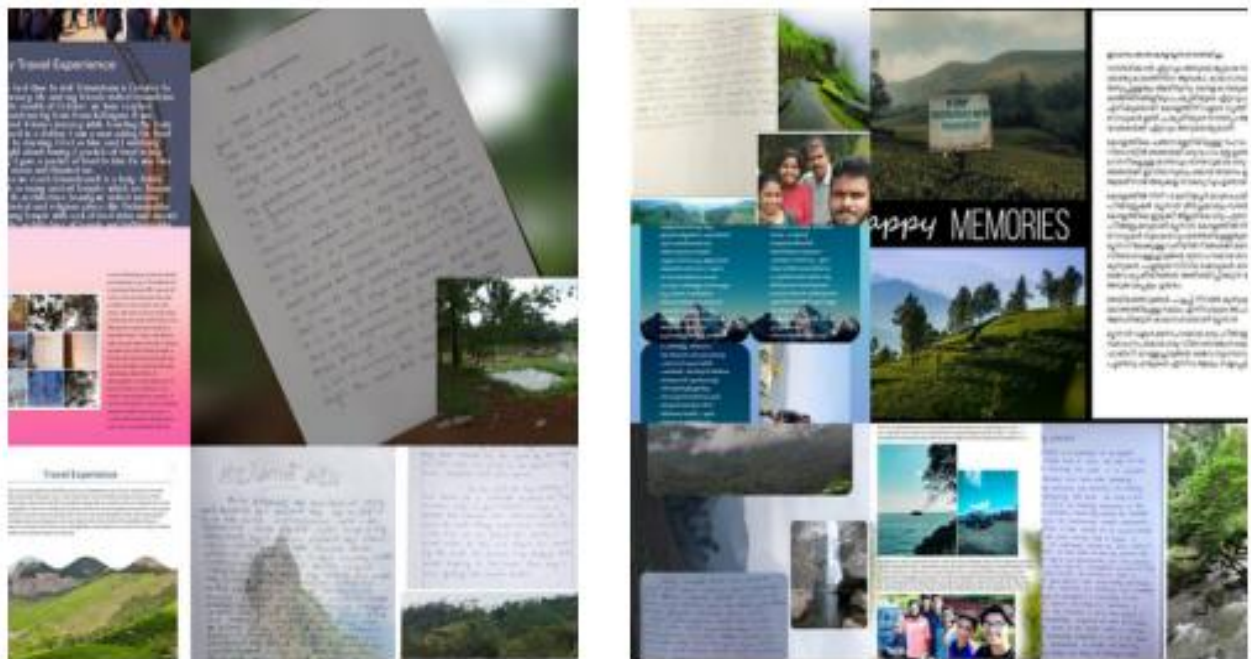

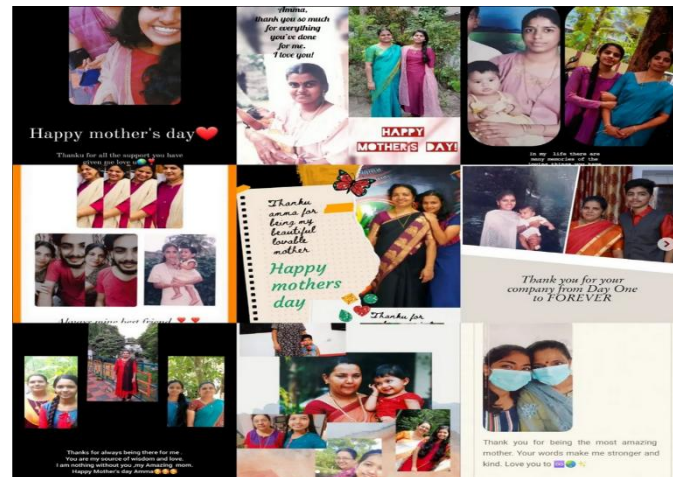
Global recycling day
