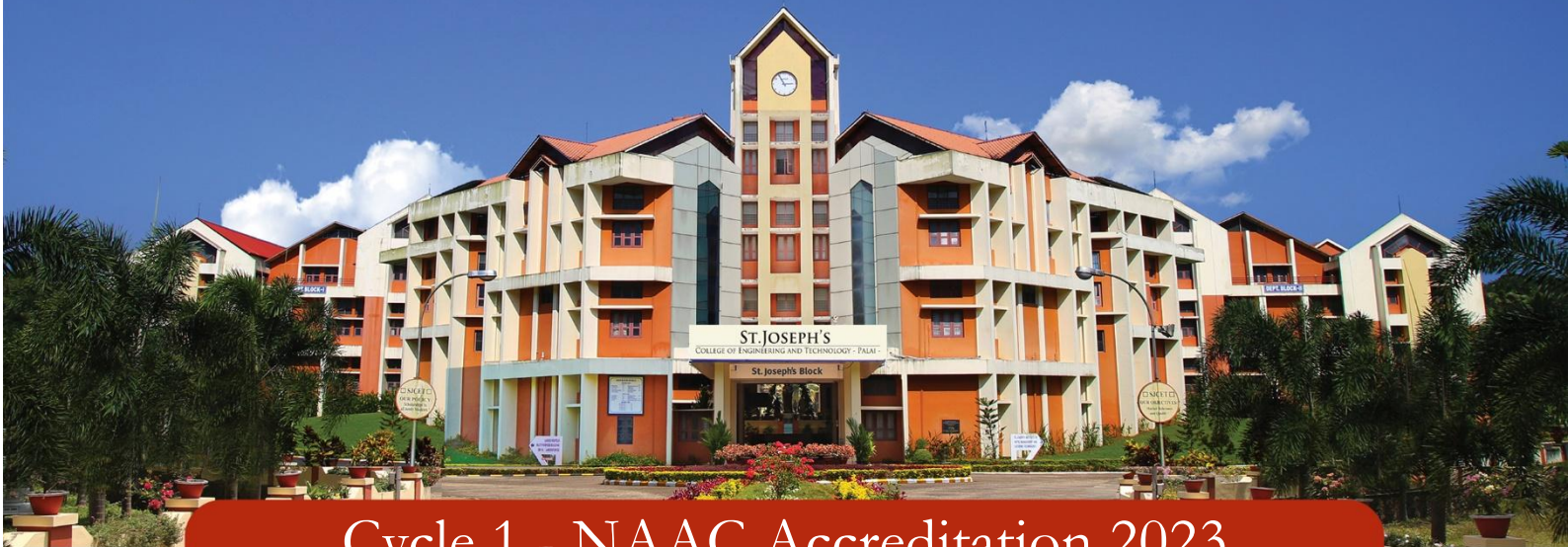

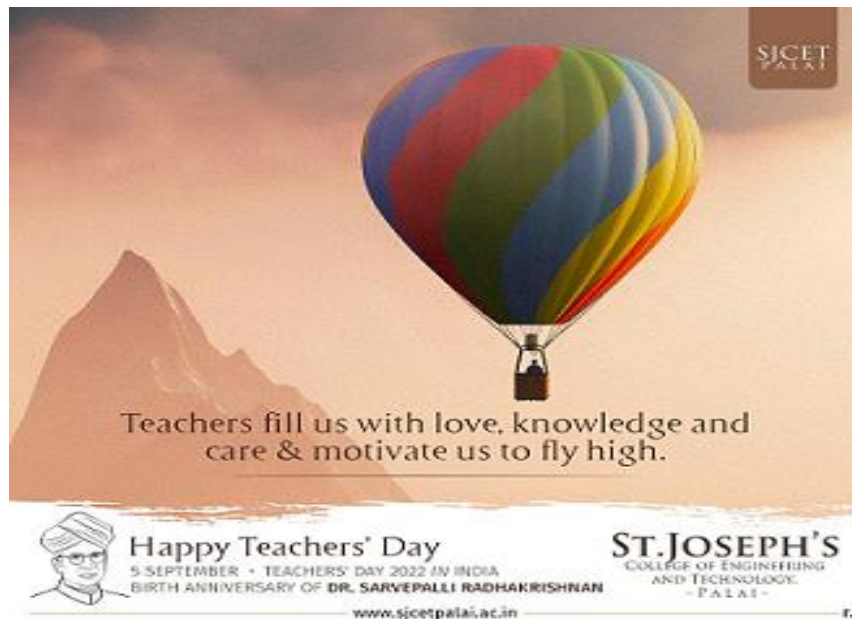
Onam celebration
