

# **Instructions to Candidates Appearing for the End Semester Examination**

#### 1. Hall Ticket and ID

- Candidates must bring their **hall ticket** and **college-issued ID card** to the exam.
- These must be presented upon request by authorized officials.
- Without a valid hall ticket, candidates will not be allowed to take the exam.
- Provisional admission **may be granted with a fine** if the candidate is on the registered list and appears eligible.

### 2. Entry to the Examination Hall

- Candidates must enter the examination hall **at least 10 minutes before** the exam begins.
- Late entry (beyond 30 minutes) after the start of the exam is not permitted.
- Candidates suffering from **infectious diseases** will not be allowed to enter.

## 3. Conduct During the Exam

- Candidates must follow all instructions given by the CoE/DCoEs and invigilators.
- Disobedience, insolence, or disruption during the exam will lead to removal from the exam hall and may result in disciplinary actions, including suspension or expulsion.
- **Strict silence** must be maintained in the examination hall.
- Any **form of communication or misconduct** will result in disciplinary action.

#### 4. Permitted Items

Candidates may bring the following items if permitted by the exam guidelines:

- 1. Hall ticket and college ID card
- 2. Drawing tools and **non-programmable calculators** (only if allowed)
- 3. IS codes, data books, tables, or handbooks as specified

## 5. Prohibited Items

The following items are **strictly prohibited** in the examination hall:

- **Electronic gadgets**: mobile phones, smartwatches, tablets, etc.
- **Books or materials** not explicitly allowed by the College
- Calculators, unless specifically permitted for the exam

## 6. Stationery

- Students must bring their **own stationery** (pens, pencils, erasers, etc.).
- Sharing of stationery is strictly prohibited.



## 7. Answer Booklets

- Only **one additional answer booklet** will be provided upon request.
- Answers must be limited to the **booklets provided**.

## 8. Leaving the Examination Hall

- Candidates are **not allowed to leave** the exam hall during the **first hour** of the exam.
- Candidates leaving early **must return the question paper** to the invigilator.

# 9. Malpractice

• Any violation of rules or engagement in malpractice will result in punitive action.

## 10. Scribes

- Scribes are allowed for eligible disabled or medically incapacitated candidates.
- Applications for scribes must be submitted along with **supporting documents at least seven days** before the exam.
