

Anti-Ragging Awareness Activities

Awareness classes were conducted by the Heads of Departments of all programmes to sensitize students about the rights and responsibilities of junior students on campus. Senior students were strictly warned against engaging in ragging activities and were made aware of the serious consequences under law and institutional rules.

As part of the Anti-Ragging Week, external expert sessions were also arranged for both junior and senior students. On 11/07/2025, an awareness talk was delivered by Adv. Ravikumar (Former AGP and PP) at St. Francis Seminar Hall. On 19/08/2025, Adv. Suman Sundar Raj, Legal Society, Palai, addressed the students and elaborated on the provisions of anti-ragging laws, the punishments for violations as per prevailing legislation, and the institutional preventive measures and grievance mechanisms in place.

To reinforce the message, anti-ragging posters were displayed across academic blocks, hostels, canteens, and the library throughout the week, serving as constant reminders to students to uphold a ragging-free campus environment.
